# Featured Announcements

## **Postdoctoral Scholar Domestic and Foreign Travel Program**

The Office of Postdoctoral Affairs is pleased to launch the <u>Postdoctoral Scholar Domestic and Foreign Travel Funds Program</u>. This program provides matching funds for active UGA postdocs to present their current research at national and international academic conferences. Matching funds (at least 1:1) must be identified and may be provided by the postdoc's research mentor/supervisor, unit, or college, or by an external travel award or grant. The maximum funding from the Office of Postdoctoral Affairs is \$1,500 per domestic trip or \$2,000 per international trip.

Applications will be reviewed in quarterly intervals, with deadlines on the second

Tuesday of August, November, February, and May. The next deadline will August 9<sup>th</sup> 2022.
