### Postdoctoral Scholar Domestic and Foreign Travel Program

The Office of Postdoctoral Affairs is pleased to launch the [Postdoctoral Scholar Domestic and Foreign Travel Funds Program](#). This program provides matching funds for active UGA postdocs to present their current research at national and international academic conferences. Matching funds (at least 1:1) must be identified and may be provided by the postdoc's research mentor/supervisor, unit, or college, or by an external travel award or grant. The maximum funding from the Office of Postdoctoral Affairs is **\$1,500** per domestic trip or **\$2,000** per international trip.

Applications will be reviewed in quarterly intervals, with deadlines on the second

Tuesday of August, November, February, and May. **The next deadline will be February 7<sup>th</sup>, 2023.**

Ryan Sibert is a postdoctoral research associate in the Joye Research Group. He received his BS in geology at Western Michigan University (WMU) in 2010, an MS in geochemistry at WMU in 2012, and his PhD in the Marine Science Department at UGA in 2021. His research explores the interactions between microbial methane dynamics and elemental cycling (e.g., S and Fe) within freshwater lakes, marine sediments, hydrothermal vents, deep sea brines, and coastal ecosystems. His current research explores the impact of methane and nitrous oxide fluxes on the long-term sequestration of carbon (i.e., “Blue Carbon”) in coastal salt marshes.
